We hope that you are enjoying your summer with family and friends. It's hard to believe we are about a month away from the full band arriving for summer band rehearsals. The 2017-2018 season is promising to be very exciting. If you are new to the Escadrille, WELCOME! Do your best to understand the information enclosed in the following documents. If you are a vet, we're glad you're back; please read everything as there may be some new information for you. Here are a few highlights regarding the 2017-2018 season:

Faculty Changes

As many of you know, Mr. Eric Gilley has taken a position in New York City. We are excited for Mr. Gilley and family as they begin their new adventure this summer. This is an exciting opportunity and wish him the very best.

We have hired a new Director of Bands at the Lowery Freshman Center! While technically official, there are a few more steps that need to be completed before we can announce the name. The new director has over 13 years teaching experience in the DFW area as a high school band director. As soon as it's 100% official, we'll send everybody an announcement.

While Dr. Philip Obado started as Director of Bands at Allen ISD on May 15th, he will begin his first full season this summer. Dr. Obado was previously Assistant Director of Bands at Baylor University, Associate Director of Bands at Illinois State University, and has taught high school band for over 12 years in the Florida public schools.

Summer Band Calendar (slightly different than past years)

Please keep up with the calendar at www.allenband.com. Percussion and Color Guard have summer rehearsals scheduled prior to the full band report time. In addition, hours and days have been redistributed based on previous year calendars due to an Allen High School academic program this summer (*Eagles Prepare to Soar* for 10th-12th graders). **FULL BAND begins on Thursday, July 27**. In addition, there is an SLT Workshop scheduled July 20-21 from 9am-4pm on both days (SLTs only, no freshmen). Details were verbally communicated in late May and an e-mail reminder went out this summer.

Spring Trip

We are planning a spring trip in late April. Included on the trip may be a possible music workshop/clinic-rehearsal and campus tour at a major university on the way. We will announce the trip once it becomes official and AISD approved this summer. The first deposit will be due at registration. We hope everyone can attend!

We are asking families to begin saving now. All fees must be paid in full at the time of registration. We will not be able to offer payment plans for the 2017-18 school year.

9th Grade Parent Meeting & General Parent Meeting – Tuesday, July 25th

STUDENT LEADERS ONLY – July 20-21 (9a-4p), July 24-26 (8a-4p)

All Student Leadership Team members will be trained on these five days. Jeremy Spicer from SASI: The Leadership People (www.studentsleading.org) will lead a seminar for all SLTs on July 20-21 (9a-4p). These two days were mentioned verbally at the end of the school year. Attendance is expected; please contact Dr. Obado if you have any issues. We will finish up our leadership training with the directors July 24-26 (8a-4p). We will combine leadership sessions, teaching workshops, and work sessions to prepare for the full band on July 27th.

FULL BAND SUMMER REHEARSALS – Thursday, July 27th – Friday, August 18th

All rehearsals will take place at Allen High School

Attendance at summer rehearsals is required of all members. The schedule from July 27-August 8 is 7:00a-4:00p each day with lunch between 11:00a-12:00p. For the most part, we will be marching outdoors in the morning and will be indoors after lunch. The schedule from August 9-August 18 is 4:00p-8:00p. Please follow the attached calendar for your specific report days and times. Please bring your lunch during summer band. Because the physical nature of our activity, students must adhere to the following guidelines: wear lightweight comfortable clothing, tennis shoes w/socks (refrain from no-show socks to avoid blisters), sunscreen, baseball caps/visors, and above all bring plenty of WATER every day. **You will be expected to have and carry your own ½ gallon water jug to all band activities including football games and band contests.** These jugs can be purchased at various retail stores. During registration, there are a number of items each student must purchase, as well as several documents that must be collected. The fees for the school year are listed in the box to the right. **Please note that Registration Day is the only tax-free day!** Normally, registration takes approximately 2-3 hours from check in to check out. Please mark your calendars for this important date. **It is very important that we collect all the fees for the upcoming school year on this day.** Please begin preparing. We ask that all fees be collected on this day. We expect 100% participation on this day. See you on Saturday, August 5th at the Allen High School PAC!

Band Polo:

The band polo shirt is worn when the full uniform is not necessary or appropriate. Students will be asked to wear their band polo with blue jeans or shorts (khaki shorts preferred). **All band members are required to purchase a polo for the 2017-2018 school year.** (The polo shirt is updated every two years.)

Black Marching Athletic Shirt and Shorts:

This athletic wear is to be worn under the marching band uniform at all times.

UIL/Game Day Refreshments:

To provide snacks and meals throughout the marching season.

Uniform Cleaning:

To provide end of the season cleaning for marching uniform and concert attire.

Ultimate Drill Book & App:

Students will be provided a drill book specifically for their spot as well as a license for an online app.

School Owned Instrument Rental:

The following AISD owned instruments *require* a usage fee: Percussion, Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, Tenor Saxophone, Bari Saxophone, Horn/Mellophone, Bass Trombone, Euphonium & Tuba. The current instrument usage fee is \$125.00 per year and covers only *part* of the yearly cleaning each instrument receives or in the case of percussion, general upkeep and drumhead replacement.

Music & Arts:

Representatives from Music & Arts will be on site to provide students with general supply needs for purchase (flip folders, extra flip folder windows, valve oil, reeds, lyres etc). Students who do not own a flip folder should purchase one (along with extra pages) on or before registration day. **Payment for these purchases should be made payable directly to Music & Arts.**

Summer Band Necessities/Requirements

- Instrument w/ Mouthpiece, reeds, etc...
- All Music
- Lyre and Flip Folder
- Drill Charts
- Tennis shoes that lace tightly with socks (No loose shoes allowed)
- Weather appropriate clothing (please do not wear all black)
- Sun Screen, Hats, Sunglasses
- NO SANDALS OR BOOTS OF ANY KIND FOR YOUR SAFETY!

ACCEPTABLE Shoes: (Running Shoes or Cross Trainers)



NON-ACCEPTABLE Shoes: (Vans, Converse, Skaters shoes, boots, flip-flops, sandals)



- Water Jug: $\frac{1}{2}$ **Gallon** in black, red, blue, or grey. (no specific brand)



- This year you will need to have your water jug with you at all fall band activities including football games and contests.
- Be sure to have your name written on top of your jug for easy identification.
