#### ARENA SCHEDULING: OPEN TO STUDENTS AFTER SPRING BREAK

Arena scheduling will be open for students after spring break. Seniors will be able to pick their classes first, followed by juniors, and so on. Please remember that your Arena schedule will only contain classes you signed up for last semester. If you did not put Band or Jazz Band in your schedule last semester, you will not be able to choose those courses after spring break. You must request a help ticket if you would like to sign up for jazz band or if you did not sign up for band. Here are a few notes:

- If you are currently in first period, you will have band offered during first period with Mrs. Pickle as your teacher. This is only a holding spot. You will be assigned the proper class/teacher after our Spring Auditions. You can be moved into an 8<sup>th</sup> period band after auditions.
- If you are currently in eighth period, you will have band offered during your eighth period with Dr. Obado as your teacher. This is only a holding spot. You will be assigned the proper class/teacher after our spring auditions. You can be moved into a 1<sup>st</sup> period band after auditions.
- If you are planning on doing Advanced Music next year, your Arena schedule WILL NOT reflect Advanced Music. Remember that only students that audition into a 1<sup>st</sup> period band next year will be able to sign-up for advanced music. If you DID NOT sign-up for advanced music, please e-mail Mr. May. It may not be too late to add you to our list. Just remember that you must be in a 1<sup>st</sup> period AHS class to be in Advanced Music.
- Classes are flexible to add/drop until May 10, 2019. Schedules are final after May 10<sup>th</sup>. You will be unable to add or drop band for any reason after May 10<sup>th</sup>.
