AHS/LFC BRASS & WOODWIND SPRING ENSEMBLE AUDITIONS (12/3-12/6)

- All students are to prepare their two region band etudes with 9th grade cuts. You will be asked to perform a 30 second cut of each etude.
- Woodwinds will report to the Orchestra Hall (1st Period) or ER (8th period) Wed-Fri by the late bell.
- Brass will report to the ER(1st Period) or Band Hall (8th Period) Wed-Fri by the late bell
- 1st Period Tues/Wed Auditions: If you are scheduled on Tuesday or Wednesday, auditions will start at 8:30am
- Attendance will be taken in the woodwind room/brass room; please show up at the beginning of class even on the days you are not auditioning.
- AHS Scales are due on Friday 12./6 at 11:59pm on Canvas. If you do not turn in scales by the due date, they will not count as part of your audition. See the chart below for the AHS audition schedule.
- LFC auditions and schedules were announced in classes the past few weeks. LFC FLUTE auditions start tomorrow (Monday 12/2). LFC major scale submissions over the past semester will count towards your audition. Your chromatic scale is due next weeki.
