Some people are wondering when a packing list will be released. A final packing list will be released closer to the trip. Here is important information to help in your shopping prep:

- There will be no formal or semi-formal events. Students are to wear school appropriate casual attire the entire duration of the trip.
- Daily high temperatures in March range between 77-80 degrees and low temperatures 64-70 degrees. Students are allowed to wear conservative two-piece bathing attire for the beach.
- Students will need khaki shorts and your Allen Escadrille Dry-Fit shirt for our performance on the USS Missouri. Color Guard performance attire will be announced by Mr. Singletary.
- Students are allowed to wear conservative bathing attire for the beach. Two-piece bathing attire is acceptable.
- Reminder that you are responsible for paying luggage fees at the airport. \$25 for the first bag, \$35 for the second EACH WAY.
